Farmland: Students will view the film Farmland, a documentary spotlighting six farmers and ranchers in the United States. The film portrays the business and lifestyle of a variety of farmers and ranchers. Perspectives on topics such as bioengineered (GMO) crops, animal welfare, organic and conventional farming practices, farm size, farming stereotypes, and more are presented. Journey 2050 Lesson 1–Sustainable Agriculture: Students will explore the question, "How will we sustainably feed nearly 10 billion people by the year 2050?" as they discover what sustainable agriculture is and how it is critical to securing a stable food supply and future for a growing population. Tracing the Agricultural Supply Chain: Explore the complexity of global commodity chains that link the production and consumption of agricultural products.
