Grades K-2 Suggested Lesson Plans

The following suggested lesson plans provide an overview of agriculture.

| Lesson Name & Description | Louisiana State Standards |
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| A Day Without Agriculture: Students explore the wide scope of agriculture, identify the variety of agricultural products they use in their daily lives, and discuss the difference between needs and wants. | ELA: L6, R2, SL1, W4 Social Studies: K.15 |
| A Search for the Source: Students determine that agriculture provides nearly all of the products we rely on in any given day by participating in a relay where they match an everyday item with its "source." | ELA : L6, SL6 Social Studies : K.15, 1.5, 1.21, 2.15.d, 2.18 |
| Agriculture and Me: Students categorize sources of basic agricultural products alphabetically. | ELA: L1, R1, R7, SL6, W4 Social Studies: K.11 |
| Agriculture Pays: Students discover that agricultural careers are interconnected and that agriculture influences many parts of their daily lives. | ELA : L1, SL1, SL2 Social Studies : 1.31, 2.17, 2.26 |
| Homegrown in Your State-Fruits and Vegetables: Students explore their state's specialty crops, discover how food gets from the farm to the table, and discuss the importance of eating fruits and vegetables every day. | ELA : SL1 Social Studies : K.11, 1.31, 2.17, 2.26 |
| My Farm Web: Students use the visual representation of a web to explore the role of agriculture in their daily lives and understand how most of the necessities of life can be traced back to the farm. | ELA : L4, SL2, W2 Science : K-ESS3-1 |
