Grades K-2 Suggested Lesson Plans

The following suggested lesson plans provide an overview of agriculture.

Lesson Name & Description	Louisiana State Standards
<u>A Day Without Agriculture</u> : Students explore the wide scope of agriculture, identify the variety of agricultural products they use in their daily lives, and discuss the difference between needs and wants.	ELA : L6, R2, SL1, W4 Social Studies : K.15
<u>A Search for the Source</u> : Students determine that agriculture provides nearly all of the products we rely on in any given day by participating in a relay where they match an everyday item with its “source.”	ELA : L6, SL6 Social Studies : K.15, 1.5, 1.21, 2.15.d, 2.18
<u>Agriculture and Me</u> : Students categorize sources of basic agricultural products alphabetically.	ELA : L1, R1, R7, SL6, W4 Social Studies : K.11
<u>Agriculture Pays</u> : Students discover that agricultural careers are interconnected and that agriculture influences many parts of their daily lives.	ELA : L1, SL1, SL2 Social Studies : 1.31, 2.17, 2.26
<u>Homegrown in Your State—Fruits and Vegetables</u> : Students explore their state’s specialty crops, discover how food gets from the farm to the table, and discuss the importance of eating fruits and vegetables every day.	ELA : SL1 Social Studies : K.11, 1.31, 2.17, 2.26
<u>My Farm Web</u> : Students use the visual representation of a web to explore the role of agriculture in their daily lives and understand how most of the necessities of life can be traced back to the farm.	ELA : L4, SL2, W2 Science : K-ESS3-1
