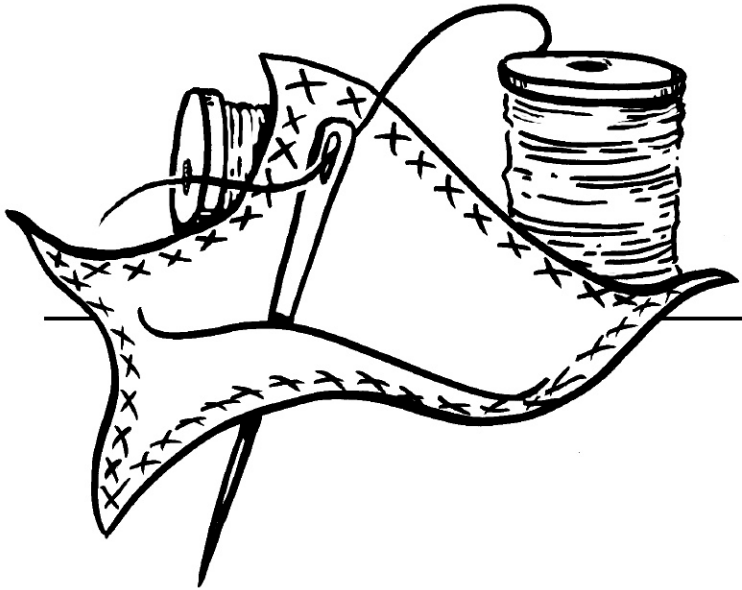


QUILTING SQUARES



Materials

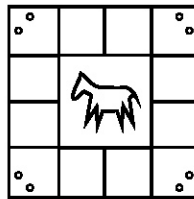
- Construction paper
- 1" fabric squares, cut with pinking shears
- Scissors
- Pinking shears
- Glue

DIRECTIONS

Pre-K through third grade activity. For younger students have all materials pre-cut. Keep it age appropriate. An excellent activity for a lesson on farm animals.

1. Cut white construction paper into large squares (5"x5", 6"x6", or 7"x7")
2. Cut farm animal shapes from construction paper.
3. Glue an animal cutout in the center of the big construction paper square.

4. Glue material squares around the sides.
(Option – laminate completed squares)
5. Punch two holes on each side of each square as shown here:



6. String squares together with yarn to make a class quilt.

Variations:

- Use colors other than white as the background color.
- Have students draw the animals or cut out pictures from magazines
- Let students make two squares – one for the class quilt and one to bring home.
