
QUILTING SQUARES





Materials


- Construction paper
- 1" fabric squares, cut with pinking shears
- Scissors
- Pinking shears
- Glue

DIRECTIONS

Pre-K through third grade activity. For younger students have all materials pre-cut. Keep it age appropriate. An excellent activity for a lesson on farm animals.

- 1. Cut white construction paper into large squares (5"x5", 6"x6", or 7"x7")
- 2. Cut farm animal shapes from construction paper.
- **3.** Glue an animal cutout in the center of the big construction paper square.

- **4.** Glue material squares around the sides. (Option laminate completed squares)
- **5.** Punch two holes on each side of each square as shown here:



6. String squares together with yarn to make a class quilt.

Variations:

- Use colors other than white as the background color.
- Have students draw the animals or cut out pictures from magazines
- Let students make two squares – one for the class quilt and one to bring home.
